The family residence shelter provides care for any age women along with her children. There is no time limit for a stay in the shelter and there is no fee. The men's shelter provides breakfast and a lunch in the afternoon. They also offer drug and alcohol rehabilitation. It is also a Christian program. One form of identification is needed for admission. The first seven nights are free of charge and \$7 per night is charged thereafter. There is no time limit to how long a man can be in the shelter.

The London House is state licensed and provides personal care to men and women over 18. It is basically home health care and nutrition. They have dentists and doctors available. There is no time limit to stay in the house and there is a sliding scale fee depending upon each individual's situation.

This is an 18 month long-term transitional living program for 16 males and 8 females ages 18-21. The program provides them with skills for independent living. Each resident helps with chores and works or attends school. It is a five level system. Residents contribute to the expenses of the home and volunteer one day per month at the Ronald McDonald House. On the job training is given and 60% of residents paycheck goes into a banking account that Covenant House keeps for resident, 20% goes towards rent, and 20% residents keep for themselves. They also offer a mother and child program called (ROPAL), life skills, employee programs, substance abuse counseling, GED and vocational education.

This program is for any young women age 19-40 who is willing to commit for a full year. This is a non-profit faith ministry and is rendered for services. There is a \$50 registration fee, but they will work with you. The ministry offers continued education, the chance to earn a GED, learn skills such as home management, gardening, and food preparation. Residents are involved in daily Bible studies, regular church attendance at the Living Water Church with group and personal prayer time. Daily physical exercise balances out the program. The women have access to a 24-hour counseling staff and a Christ centered school.
