This program sets on a 100-acre ranch with a gym and pool. They house up to 33 boys ages 8-17. Boys who are accepted are those who are needy, dependent, neglected or pre-delinquent and CINS. Public schools are attended and there is a sliding scale fee.

While the program is non-denominational, the boys attend church and bible study. This is an ideal location for youth requiring long-term behavior modification in an affectionate but structured setting. There is no fee for their services.

This Christian program is able to take up to 24 boys ages 1-16. It also offers a therapeutic wilderness/discovery camp for ages 10 to adult. Residential care is \$830 per month. Faith Ranch works with boys who have various emotional and academic difficulties such as ADD and ADHD. This is not a place for juveniles who are criminally deviant or have severe character or conduct disorders. They provide on-site schooling, tutoring, and vocational training.
